**Collection summary:** The collection consists of over 350 physical books and audio visual materials. **Biographical note:** The collection was created by John Connolly, Secretary of the Lifesaving

Foundation.

**Collection description:** The Lifesaving Foundation is an international charity devoted to saving lives from drowning. The Foundation's primary aim is to promote and support evidence-based research into drowning prevention and rescue.

The Lifesaving Foundation has formed a drowning research partnership with SETU's School of Health Sciences. The long-term aim of the partnership is to establish a permanent world class drowning research centre at SETU. The immediate aim is to reduce drowning death numbers through researching the concept of self-rescue in life threatening situations. This is being undertaken in cooperation with An Garda Síochána and An Garda Síochána Retired Members Association. Initial funding will be provided through the Doherty Police Research Fund.

**Acquisition note:** On Thursday 1st February 2018, a large donation of drowning books was made to WIT Libraries (now SETU Libraries) by John Connolly, Secretary of the Lifesaving Foundation as part of the launch of a research partnership between the School of Health Sciences and The Lifesaving Foundation. This donation of books and audio visual materials will be known as the Lifesaving Foundation Collection.
